**Official Spelling Bee Rules:**

The pronouncer will say the word 2 times. The speller may ask for it to be used in a sentence. The speller will have 1 minute to spell the word.

Once the speller begins to spell the word, they may begin again but must spell the word exactly as they had before and continue on with their final spelling. They may not retrace and start over changing their spelling. If they do, even if the word is spelled correctly, the speller will be disqualified for not spelling it correctly.

Remember, the judges will have the final say on disqualification or allowance to return to the competition.

If a speller gets the word right we will ring the bell—speller returns to their seat. In the case of misspelling, the head judge will state the correct spelling and the speller gives up his/her number and returns to their seat.

The spelling bee will continue until the last 2 spellers are standing.

Final round: Speller A and B

A spells the word correct and so does B. Round 2: A misses the word B misses the word. Round 3: A spells their word correct B misses his. For speller A to win he must spell an additional word correctly. That qualifies him/her to be the winner. Should he spell the additional word wrong, A and B will then go another round until only one person is able to spell their word correctly and an additional word.

We agree to the Official Spelling Bee Rules and understand that the judges will have the final say on disqualification or allowance to return to the competition.
