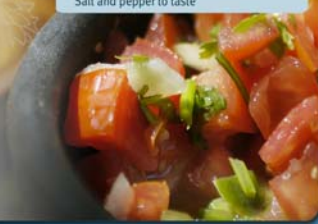
Cilantro Salsa

Directions

1. Mince garlic in food processor.
2. Add onion and peppers and pulse in food processor until coarsely chopped.
3. Add tomatoes and cilantro, and process until combined but slightly chunky.
4. Add salt and pepper to taste.
5. Refrigerate until ready to use.

Ingredients:

- 2 Cloves garlic
- 1 large onion, quartered
- 3 to 4 jalapeno peppers
- 1 green bell pepper, quartered and seeded
- 6 tomatoes, peeled, seeded and chopped or 2 cans (16 oz each)
- 1 cup fresh cilantro
- Plum tomatoes, drained and chopped
- Salt and pepper to taste

Helping Our Neighbors in Mexico

Many of you have asked what you can do to help our neighbors south of Mexicali in the wake of the 7.2 earthquake that struck that area on Easter Sunday. KGBA Radio and the Westmorland Presbyterian Church are collecting items to send to those in dire need of provisions. A caravan of trucks is going down every Saturday morning and will continue for at least another month. Here are the items needed (and not needed) at this time.

Needed:

Hygiene products such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, etc.
Anti-bacterial wipes, Sanitary napkins, Toilet paper and Diapers.
Canned food with pop top lids (many do not have can openers!)
Boxed, non-perishable food items
Bottled water
Water proof tarps or tents

Not Needed: (These items will not be loaded on the trucks or taken across the border as they take up space needed for vital survival supplies.)

Perishable food
Clothing
Shoes

Blankets, towels, washcloths, etc. (Nothing cloth!)

Please put your items in BOXES (grocery bags are difficult to load, unload and transport.) We will collect items at the church and arrange to have them delivered to KGBA on Friday afternoons. Items can also be left at the Westmorland Chamber of Commerce (City Hall).
