Very determined lil girl to overcome any obstacles that may come my way. I was born on Feb. 2, 2010 to my mother Esmeralda Diaz. I was born with some physical limitations that no one knew I would have at birth till the day I was actually born. I was born with bilateral clubfeet, bilateral hip dysplasia, hip dislocation and also found out that I was born without sockets, arthrogryposis, and some mild scoliosis. I have been through lots since the day I was born. Which included having casts on my feet till I was at least 10 months. At 11 months I had surgery on my left foot where doctors discovered I had very little to no muscle and would not have the chance to walk, which meant I would be in a wheelchair. But miracles do happen and my doctor discovered in March of 2011 that my sockets were now developing, which meant I would have the opportunity to walk. I will be going through major surgery in the month of November to hopefully correct my hips and have the chance to walk. Despite my obstacles I am very determined and nothing has stopped me now. I might be lil but I am a fighter!! I have FAITH!!!!
