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Ballot Notification Explained to Voters

The Imperial County Registrar of Voters has been informed that voters registered with BallotTrax were advised that their ballot for November 3rd General Election has not been received.

BallotTrax is a mail ballot locator and notification system which voters can register with to track the processing of their mail-in ballot. Information is obtained by a synchronized system connected to election data.

When voters mail or drop ballots off at an official ballot drop off location, there is a series of processes and verification steps that must be followed by election officials. Due to the high volume of ballots currently being received by the Registrar's Office, voters should expect this process to take longer than past election cycles.

Recipients of this message should not assume that the Registrar's Office has not received their ballot and voters should not be overly concerned. Ballots are being processed and new updates are synchronized with the BallotTrax system each day.

The Registrar's staff will continue to work diligently to process ballots as they are received and wishes to thank the public for their patience.
