



# REMEMBER ON COLLECTION DAY

- 1 The carts should be placed at the curbside no later than 6:30 am on collection day and removed from the curbside within 12 hours after service.
- 2 The carts should be placed with the handles and wheels facing towards your home.
- 3 Place carts side-by-side approximately 1 foot apart & at least 3 feet from any obstruction (i.e. vehicles, fire hydrants, trees).
- 4 Items placed outside of carts will not be collected. Cart lids should be closed. Please do not overload.



# ADDITIONAL SERVICES AVAILABLE

#### **BULKY ITEMS**

Items that cannot fit in your automated carts are considered bulky items. Bulky items must be manageable by a two-person crew. Residents can now order a bulky item pick-up through our website at www.crrwasteservices.com. Click Bulky or E-Waste to place an order. You may also arrange a collection by calling Customer Service at 760.482,5656.

# WHITE GOODS / HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES

White goods, or household appliances containing freon are picked up similar to a bulky item. Refrigerators contain freon and other chemicals that require special handling. CR&R will collect bulky items and white goods from your curbside.

#### **E-WASTE**

Electronic Waste (e-waste) is anything with a circuit board or battery powered. It is illegal to dispose of e-waste in any of your automated carts. CR&R will collect and legally dispose of and recycle these items.

Hazardous wastes are products that are flammable, corrosive, reactive or toxic. Discarded batteries are hazardous waste in California. Therefore, it is illegal to dispose of them in regular trash or recycling; so don't place them in collection containers. This includes batteries of all types and sizes: Alkaline (AAA, AA, C, D, 9 volt), Lithium-ion (button cell, power tool batteries, camera batteries, other electronics), Ni-Cad (power tools), and battery types both rechargeable and single use.

Batteries can be taken to one of the following locations:

- · Household hazardous waste disposal facility
- Local retailer (Home Depot, Lowes, Best Buy, Staples, Ikea, etc)

Why is it important? When lithium-ion batteries are improperly disposed of they can cause fires in recycling centers, landfills, and collection trucks.

# **SHARPS**

Disposal of needles, lancets and other home-generated sharps in your trash and recycling bins is hazardous and illegal. Needles, lancets and other home generated sharps may be collected in an approved puncture proof container and recycled through local pharmacies.
